

# School Fees for the Academic Year 2023 - 2024

#### **Registration Fee:**

For UK students, a non-returnable £90 registration fee is payable when you register your child for a place at Tettenhall College. For non-UK students the registration fee is £120.

(Pupils progressing from Tettenhall College's Preparatory School to the Senior School are not required to pay a further registration fee.)

# Acceptance Deposit:

An acceptance deposit is required when the formal offer letter from the Head is received; this guarantees your child a place at the school. This deposit is held and refunded, less any outstanding charges, on the pupil leaving the school.

UK Pupils: £500

Non-UK Pupils: £1,000

Where a pupil is entering the College Nursery or Pre-School, a £1,000 acceptance deposit is required to secure the place. £500 of this deposit will be deducted from the first term's fees, once the pupil enters Reception class. In the event a pupil does not join the Reception class, the deposit is not refunded.

#### **School Fees:**

At Tettenhall College we attempt, as far as possible, to include all elements of your child's education in the fee so that parents are aware of the total cost. Therefore, we do not make any additional charges for the following:

- Any travel associated with school sports matches (excluding optional trips)
- All timetabled sports
- Wi-F

Boarding students also have all accommodation, meals, bedding & supervised studies included. Laundry services are provided to full boarders.

# Additional Charges:

These may be incurred each term for school buses, taxis, individual music lessons, school trips, school photographs, examination fees, boarders' outings. Parental permission will normally be sought if an additional item of expenditure is in excess of £30. Charges for Academic Support are arranged on an individual basis, subject to the level of support required.

#### Transport:

The School operates several week day mini-bus services. The School can usually accommodate specific stops along a route. The mini-bus team strives to ensure there is an opportunity to support every family that requires the service, to safely enable their children to get 'to and from' school each day. Please see website for details of the routes and charges.

# International Students:

For pupils whose first language is not English the school provides a professional and dedicated 'English as an Additional Language' (EAL) service. This is fully integrated into the weekly timetable. Upon arrival each pupil is assessed and an appropriate programme of EAL lessons recommended.

EAL fees: £595 per term

### **Sibling Discount:**

A 10% reduction is applied to the fees for a second sibling, a 15% reduction to the fees for a third and a 20% reduction for the fourth. The reduction is applied to the younger of the siblings.

#### Insurance:

Personal Accident, incorporating Dental insurance, is compulsory for all pupils. The cost is £5 per term. Personal Effects Insurance is available for all pupils and is compulsory for Boarders. The cost is £4.80 per term. Other options are available on request.

#### Payment terms:

The Governors require that fees must be paid by the first day of term unless arrangements have been made to pay monthly through the School Fee Plan. Please contact the Bursary for more information.

### **Important Information:**

- In the event of the withdrawal of a pupil, notice should be given a full term in advance, or in lieu of such a full term's fees will be charged.
- Please see the College's Terms and Conditions for further information about the payment of Fees and extras.
- The College's Terms and Conditions are available on request from the Bursar's Office or from the Admissions Office.
- A weekly boarder is a pupil resident at the College from Monday Friday nights inclusive.
- A limited number of scholarship and bursary awards are made each year. Children of service personnel or the clergy may also be eligible for a bursary award. For more information, please contact the Admissions Department.
- A 1.25% reduction in fees is available if parents pay a year's fees in advance.
- On request, Old Tettenhallians are eligible for a 10% reduction in fees for their children.

#### **Notes:**

- The 15 hours Early Year's Fee Discount is applicable the term after a child turns 3 years of age until the term they turn 5 years of age.
- Full time nursery & all pre-school sessions include lunch and/ or tea. For half day nursery, lunch or tea is charged at £3.50 per day.
- Lunch in the Preparatory School is compulsory and charged at £210 per term.
- Lunch in the Senior School is compulsory and is charged at £252 per term.
- There are 3 terms per academic year.

### Wrap Around Care Charges:

- Breakfast Club operates from 7.30am at £3.50 per day. This applies to all year groups.
- Nursery & Pre-School supervision is from 8am to 6pm and is included in the overall fee. Tea will be charged at £3.50 per day.
- For Prep School there is no charge for after school supervision. Children staying between 5.00pm 6pm will receive tea, which is charged at £3.50 per day.
- Holiday Club information is published termly in advance.

## Flexible Boarding & Senior Tea Fees:

- Flexible boarding is charged at:

Y5 - Y9 £40 per night
Y10 -13 £51 per night

- Flexible Weekly boarding is £225 per week.

Tea for Senior School Day pupils is £4.55 per night.
