For junior boarders, we have a busy, exciting and effective programme that ensures they settle into the school quickly, build friendships and make a strong academic start to their studies.

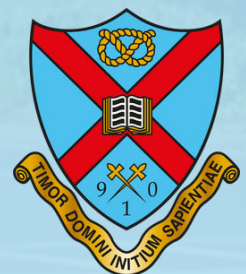
We also deliver a wonderful range of Arts, Sport, Drama and Music, with first rate facilities throughout our beautiful campus.

Our integration programmes are excellent options for students to experience real life in a traditional British school, where the majority of students are from the UK and where everything is delivered in English. Students joining our integration are fully immersed into the school. The only time a student will be in a group with just international students, is when they are taking dedicated English Language classes (EAL).

Whilst the majority of students at Tettenhall College are British, we are a global community, where 22% of students come from more than 30 different countries (spanning 5 different continents). We believe that every child is a valued global citizen, and we work to ensure that this is at the heart of our education and ethos.

Most of all, an integration stay, really allows a student and their family to see why Tettenhall College is such a strong choice for their onward study and for their future personal and academic success.

WELCOME



Each year, Tettenhall College is delighted to welcome a small number of students to its beautiful campus, to experience an authentic and high-quality study and boarding programme. Students are fully integrated into our school, attending all classes with local students, living on campus in our boarding houses, and taking part in all sports, arts and other activities

This project is open to both boys and girls, aged between 10 - 17 years of age.

The options available are:

- **A group stay of between 10 - 14 days**, for a minimum of 8 students and a maximum of 20 students. Group stays are carefully limited to ensure they do not impact on the smooth running of the school for our full-time students. Subject to availability.
- **A short-term immersion programme** for small groups of students (between 3 - 8 in one group), who will stay from between 3 - 6 weeks.
- **A mid-length integration programme of one term to one year**, for individual students who are looking for a real experience of British education and of life within in a historic British boarding school.

LOCATION

Tettenhall is a beautiful village in the heart of the English Midlands. Close to Staffordshire & Shropshire, Tettenhall is a safe and lovely location. The village has a vibrant high street with many shops, coffee shops and restaurants that our boarding students love to use. There is also a bank, pharmacy, bakery, boutiques, gift shops and many hairdressers/ beauticians.

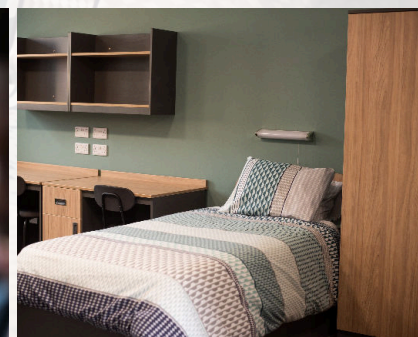
Junior boarders share their bedrooms – these rooms are 3 – 4 beds maximum.
