

Marrakech

Students explore the vibrant heart of Marrakech, from the winding souks and traditional apothecaries to iconic sites such as the Koutoubia Mosque and Jemaa el-Fna Square.

High Atlas Mountains

Crossing the Tizi-n-Tichka Pass and passing mountain villages, students experience Morocco's striking landscapes and rural life. Stops at Aït Benhaddou and Ouarzazate reveal the area's rich history and culture.

Sahara Desert

Students journey into the Erg Chebbi dunes and take part in a sunset camel ride, stay overnight in a Bedouin camp, and enjoy traditional music and stargazing in the desert environment.

Vimy Ridge Memorial

A powerful first stop on the tour, the Vimy Ridge Memorial gives students the chance to walk the preserved trenches and learn how Canadian forces shaped a turning point in the First World War.



Explore the Somme

From Sheffield Memorial Park to Newfoundland Park, Lochnagar Crater and Sunken Lane, students explore some of the most significant locations of the Somme.



Day Trip to Ypres

The full-day visit to Ypres includes the Flanders Field Museum, Tyne Cot Cemetery and Essex Farm, offering broader perspective on the conflict.

Ski Instruction

Students receive structured lessons from local ski instructors, with a minimum of twenty hours of instruction across the week. The Galibier Thabor ski area provides a range of slopes suitable for developing skills at all levels.

Time on the Mountain

With a five-day ski pass and full equipment hire included, students spend their days progressing on varied terrain and enjoying the alpine environment around Valloire and Valmeinier.

Evenings at La Pulka

La Pulka offers a comfortable base close to the lifts, with full-board meals and communal spaces for downtime. Evening activities include bowling, Snake Glisse, and a ski school presentation with individual feedback.
